ORDINANCE NO. 20145

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2013/2014 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, FROM ANTICIPATED REVENUES OF \$502,789.08 TO ANTICIPATED REVENUES OF \$553,689.08.

WHEREAS, throughout the 2013/2014 fiscal year the Board of Aldermen approved expenditures from other City Funds, thus altering the proposed Budget for the 2013/2014 fiscal year from anticipated revenues of \$502,789.08, that included \$67,000.00 from the Street Fund, to anticipated revenues of \$553,689.08.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS, MISSOURI:

SECTION 1: On Friday, June 28, 2013, at an Emergency Board of Aldermen Meeting, the Board authorized borrowing \$20,000 from the Water Fund to enter into a Contract with WET RPM to provide emergency services to run the City's water distribution and sewer plant.

SECTION 2: At the Regular Wednesday, July 24, 2013 Board of Aldermen Meeting the Board authorized spending \$25,000 from the Sewer Depreciation Fund for sewer plant repairs.

SECTION 3: At the Regular Wednesday, May 21, 2014 Board of Aldermen Meeting it was noted that the Board had authorized by a phone vote to borrow up to \$5,900 from the water fund to purchase a 2009 Ford Crown Vic as a police vehicle.

SECTION 4: The proposed 2013/2014 Budget is hereby amended to show these authorized expenditures from City Funds thus showing anticipated revenues of \$553,689.08, that included \$67,000.00 from the Street Fund. A copy of the amended schedule for the proposed 2013/2014 year general budget marked Amended Schedule "A", is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 5: The Amended 2013/2014 Budget is hereby approved and it is directed that said amended Budget be used by the Mayor, Board of Aldermen, and all officials, personnel and agents of the City of Wood Heights as a guide for revenue and appropriations for fiscal year 2013/2014.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its date of passage and approval. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
