

ORDINANCE NO. 585

BILL NO. 585

AN ORDINANCE FOR APPOINTING OFFICERS, TERMS, FOR THE CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS; SETTING EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS ORDINANCE AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

The City Attorney shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the consent and approval of a majority of the members of the Board of Alderman. The City Attorney shall be paid according to individual contract with the City of Wood Heights. The City Attorney shall hold the office on a month to month basis.

SECTION II

A clerk to be known as the City Clerk shall be appointed by the Board of Aldermen. This officer shall be an employee of the City of Wood Heights, and the rate of pay shall be on an hourly basis. The City Clerk shall hold the position on a month to month basis, as an at will employee.

SECTION III

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its date of passage.
