ORDINANCE NO. 20140

AN ORDINANCE CALLING AND PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF AN ELECTION WITHIN AND FOR THE CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS, RAY COUNTY, MISSOURI, TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, THE 8TH DAY OF APRIL, 2014, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO AND TESTING THE SENSE OF THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, ON THE QUESTION OF INCREASING THE TAX RATE OF THE CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, IN COMPLIANCE WITH STATE LAW PRESCRIBING THE FORM OF BALLOT TO BE USED THEREAT, SETTING OUT THE FORM OF NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION AND DIRECTING ITS PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, the Board of Alderman of the City of Wood Heights, Ray County, Missouri, deems it necessary and advisable to provide funds to meet the cost of street repairs and maintenance, and

WHEREAS, the said Board of Alderman finds that there are not sufficient funds available in the City treasury to provide the level of services desired by the citizens of Wood Heights, Missouri, for street repairs and maintenance, and

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 22, of the Constitution of the State of Missouri, requires that voters must approve any increase in taxes, licenses and fees:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That at the next election to be held in the City of Wood Heights, Missouri, on Tuesday, the 8th day of April, 2014, for the purpose of submitting to and testing the sense of the qualified voters of said City upon the following proposition:

Proposition Number One. To Increase the tax levy of the City of Wood Heights, Missouri, in the amount of thirty (\$.30) cent on the one hundred dollars valuation for street repairs and maintenance. The ballots used in said election will be in substantially the following form:

Shall there be a thirty (\$.30) cent increase in tax levy on one hundred dollars valuation for general municipal purposes for street repairs and maintenance for four (4) years in the City of Wood Heights, Missouri?



Section 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
