AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO THE ACCEPTANCE BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF WOOD HEIGHTS, RAY COUNTY, MISSOURI, OF THE APRIL 3RD, 1962, ELECTION OF NEW TRUSTEES BY THE VILLAGE OF WOOD HEIGHTS.
