ORDINANCE NO. 141

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A MINIMUM DISTANCE BETWEEN DUSK TO DAWN LIGHTING. TO AURTHORIZE MISSOURI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY TO INSTALL ADDITIONAL DUSK TO DAWN LIGHTS AS PER CONTRACT.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Wood Heights, Missouri, as follows:

- Section 1: (a) The minimum distance between dusk to dawn lights, to be billed to the City, shall be three hundred (300) feet.
- (b) When the minimum of three hundred (300) feet is not possible, because of a nonexisting utility pole, at that distance, it may be installed on an existing utility pole nearest to the three hundred (300) feet minimum distance, as mentioned in this Ordinance.

Section 2: Missouri Power & Light Company is hereby aurtherized to install a dusk to dawn light on an existing utility pole behind the residents of Harry Young and also on an existing utility pole behind the residents of Stuart Sharp.

Section 3: Missouri Power & Light Company is hereby aurtherized to bill the dusk to dawn light, that is presently billed to Joe H. Cox, to the Village of Wood Heights.
