

ORDINANCE NO. 980409-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 512 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, RELATING TO CITY STICKERS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES; SETTING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF SUCH ORDINANCE; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS SHALL AMEND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 512 TO READ AS FOLLOWS: THE COST OF EACH CITY STICKER SHALL BE AT THE RATE OF \$5.00 PER STICKER.

SECTION 2. CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS SHALL AMEND ORDINANCE 512 BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING: ANY PERSON, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION THAT REQUIRES A REPLACEMENT STICKER, DUE TO LOSS OF ORIGINAL PURCHASED STICKER WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF THE ORIGINAL PURCHASE DATE SHALL BE CHARGED A COST OF ONE (\$1) DOLLAR. ANY PERSON, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION THAT REQUIRES A REPLACEMENT STICKER, DUE TO LOSS OF ORIGINAL PURCHASED STICKER THIRTY ONE (31) DAYS OR MORE ^{OF} ~~OF~~ THE ORIGINAL PURCHASE DATE SHALL BE CHARGED A COST OF FIVE (\$5) DOLLARS.

SECTION 3. CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS SHALL AMEND ORDINANCE 512 BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING: ANY PERSON, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION THAT REQUIRES A REPLACEMENT STICKER, DUE TO THE PURCHASE OF A NEW VEHICLE, SHALL BE CHARGED A COST OF ONE (\$1) DOLLAR, PROVIDING THEY SUBMIT THE CITY CLERK WITH COPIES OF THE NEW REGISTRATION AND OR BILL OF SALE WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF THE PURCHASE OF THE REPLACEMENT VEHICLE.

SECTION 4. CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS SHALL AMEND ORDINANCE 512 BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING: ANY PERSON, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION THAT REQUIRES A REPLACEMENT STICKER, DUE TO THE REPLACEMENT OF A WINDSHIELD SHALL BE CHARGED A COST OF ONE (\$1) DOLLAR, PROVIDING THEY SUBMIT THE CITY CLERK WITH COPIES OF THE REPAIR BILL WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF THE PURCHASE OF THE REPLACEMENT WINDSHIELD.

SECTION 5. CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS SHALL AMEND ORDINANCE 512 SECTION 6 AS FOLLOWS: ANY PERSON, PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION VIOLATING ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE FINED NOT LESS THAN ONE (\$1) NOR MORE THAN FIVE (\$500) HUNDRED DOLLARS. EACH DAY SUCH VIOLATION IS COMMITTED SHALL CONSTITUTE A SEPARATE OFFENSE AND SHALL BE PUNISHABLE AS HEREIN BEFORE SET FORTH.

SECTION 6. ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES THAT CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

SECTION 7. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT DECEMBER 31, 1998 AFTER PASSAGE AND APPROVAL.
