ORDINANCE NO 10

AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO THE LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF A PROPERTY TAX OF TEN CENTS PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS VALUATION UPON ALL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF WOOD HEIGHTS AND PROVIDING FOR AN ELECTION TO GET VOTER APPROVAL FOR SUCH LEVY AND ASSESSMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF WOOD HEIGHTS AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I

There is hereby levied and assessed the sum of Ten Cents per one hundred dollars valuation upon all real property lying within the corporate limits of the Town of Wood Heights.

ARTICLE II

Said tax shall be due and payable on November 1, 1961, and become delinquent on January 1, 1962. Collections of said tax shall be made by the City Collector.

ARTICLE III

The proposition to assess and levy the aforesaid tax shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the Town of Wood Heights at its regular election held April 4, 1961, and the ballots shall be in substantially the following form:

For ten cent levy and assessment on one hundred dollars valuation for general municipal purposes for 1961.

Against ten cent levy and assessment on one hundred dollars valuation for general municipal purposes for 1961.  
(Place an "X" in the square opposite the one for which you wish to vote.)

ARTICLE IV.

If a majority of the qualified voters voting at such general election shall vote for the levy, the same shall be assessed and collected as provided by law.
