ORDINANCE NO. 249.

AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES ON CITY PROPERTY, OTHER THAN SPECIFIED ROADS, STREETS, AND TRAFFICWAYS USED FOR PUBLIC CONVEYANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WOOD HEIGHTS, MO., AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The driving, parking, or other use of motorized vehicles on property belonging to the City of Wood Heights, Mo., other than specified roads, streets, and trafficways, marked, and/or maintained for public conveyance shall be prohibited.
- Section 2. Only motorized vehicles authorized by the Council of Wood Heights, Mo., for use in maintenance, repair, or emergency services, shall be deemed not in violation of this Ordinance, as stated in Section 1.
- Section 3. The Driving, parking, or other use of any motorized vehicle on the dam of the Woods Lake, other than motorized vehicles authorized by the Council of Wood Heights, Mo., for maintenance, repair, or emergency services shall be deemed a violation of this Ordinance as authorized in Section 1 of this Ordinance, but said enumeration shall not be deemed exclusive to Section 1.
- Section 4. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than \$ 5.00 (Five dollars), nor more than \$ 100.00 (One Hundred dollars), for such offense.
- Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and approval, as provided by law.
