ORDINANCE NO. 597

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE WEARING OF PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR BY ANY PERSON OPERATING A MOTORCYCLE OR MOTORTRICYCLE WITHIN THE CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS, MISSOURI; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT AND PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF WOOD HEIGHTS, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. For purposes of this Ordinance, a motorcycle is defined as a motor vehicle operated on two wheels and a motortricycle is defined as a motor vehicle operated on three wheels.

SECTION 2. Every person operating or riding as a passenger on a motorcycle or motortricycle as defined in this Ordinance, upon any road, street or highway of the City of Wood Heights, Missouri, shall wear protective headgear at all times while the vehicle is in motion. The protective headgear shall meet reasonable standards and specifications as established by the Director of Revenue of the State of Missouri.

SECTION 3. Any person violating any provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be fined in an amount of (\$25.00) twenty-five dollars. No court costs shall be imposed upon any person due to such violation.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances that conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
